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## **Authorised Witnesses**

In accordance with the *Oaths Act* 1936, any of the following persons may witness the signing of a statutory declaration within South Australia;

- · A Justice of the peace
- A notary public of South Australia, the Commonwealth or another State
- A <u>proclaimed</u> member of the South Australian Police Force (found at most South Australian police stations)
- · A Commissioner for affidavits includes
  - Judge or Master of the Supreme Court
  - o Judge or Master of the District Court
  - All Magistrates
  - Registrars and Deputy Registrars of the Supreme Court, Districts Court, Industrial Relations Court, Youth Court and the Magistrates Court
  - Legal practitioners listed on the roll of practitioners of the Supreme Court of South Australia
  - Any other person appointed by the Governor to be Commissioners for taking Affidavits in the Supreme Court.

## **WARNING**

It is a criminal offence to provide a false declaration. Where Care Park has evidence that indicates the content of a statutory declaration is untrue, it is company policy to **refer the matter to police for investigation and prosecution**.
