Authorised Witnesses

- · a justice of the peace
- · a notary public
- · a legal practitioner
- · the Registrar or Deputy Registrar of a court
- · a Judge of a court
- · a Master of a court
- · a police officer
- · the Sheriff or Sheriff's Officer
- a member or former member of either house of the Parliament of the Commonwealth of Australia
- a member or former member of either house of the Parliament of Tasmania
- · a member of a local government authority of a State or Territory
- · a medical practitioner
- · a dentist
- · a veterinary practitioner
- a pharmacist
- a nurse
- · a psychologist
- a chiropractor
- · an optometrist
- · a patent attorney
- · a physiotherapist
- an agent of Australia Post who is in charge of an officer supplying postal services to the public
- a teacher employed on a full time basis at a school or tertiary education institution
- · a bank officer with five or more continuous years of service
- · a minister of religion
- · a clerk of a court
- · a Commissioner for Declarations
- · a Commissioner for Affidavits
- a Magistrate

WARNING
