

Statutory Declaration

Authorised Witnesses

In accordance with the *Oaths Act 1867*, any of the following persons may witness the signing of a statutory declaration within Queensland;

- a Justice, commissioner for declarations or notary public under the law of the State, the Commonwealth or another State; or
- a lawyer; or
- a conveyancer, or another person authorised to administer an oath, under the law of the State, the Commonwealth or another State.

WARNING

It is a criminal offence to provide a false declaration. Where Care Park has evidence that indicates the content of a statutory declaration is untrue, it is company policy to **refer the matter to police for investigation and prosecution.**
